

Trips Behaviour Policy and Procedures

The Team Leader of each planned trip will consider each student who wishes to go on the trip in light of their behaviour record in school or on previous trips including extra-curricular activities.

The school retains the right not to allow students to go on trips if there are concerns about their behaviour.

Each trip will be reviewed in the light of staffing, activities and category of risk (see Swindon LA categories A, B and C)

“Teachers who engage in outdoor activities are entitled to an expectation of obedience to discipline, self-discipline, common-sense and responsible behaviour from students in their care.” (Swindon LA Guidance for Trips and Visits 2004)

Therefore the number of W2/W3/W4 each student has will be taken into consideration.

- Team Leaders will consider whether the student poses a Health and Safety risk because he/she has failed to follow instructions either in school or on a previous trip or has shown acts of aggression.
- Year Leaders will maintain a list of students whom they consider to be of concern. This will be reviewed three times a year – In Term 1, Term 3 and Term 5

Students who are on exclusion levels will have the following conditions:

Level 2 – prohibited from going on foreign trips

Level 3 – Prohibited from going on local and national trips
