Midwives support pregnant women and their babies before, during and after, childbirth. You could work at a client's home, at a health centre, at a GP practice or in an NHS or private hospital.

You can expect to earn £24,907 to £44,503 per year, work 40 hours per week and be on call evenings and weekends. There is expected to be 6% more midwives needed by 2025.
